The efforts of Ganga house and Laxmi house was crowned with first and second position respectively.





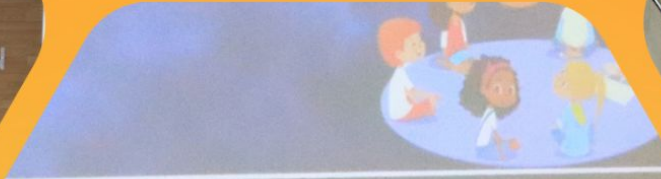
POETRY

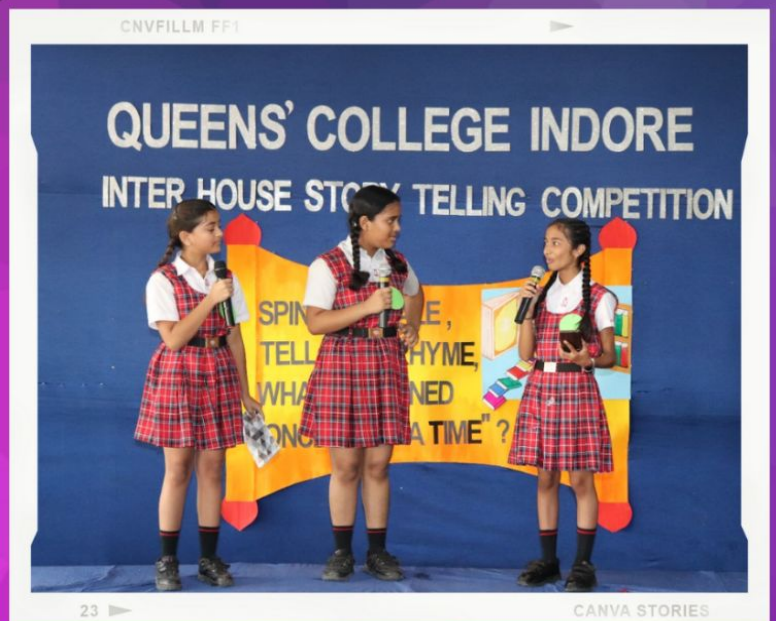

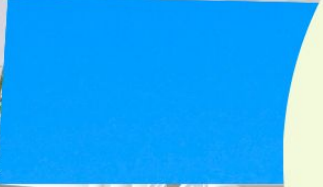
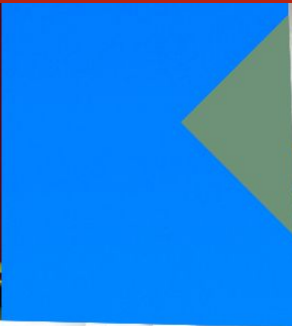


QED TALKS

INTER HOUSE HINDI GROUP SONG COMPETITION

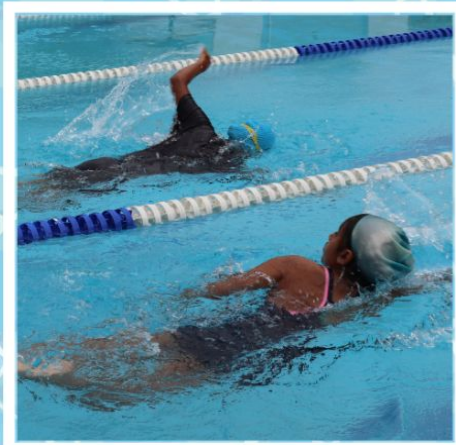

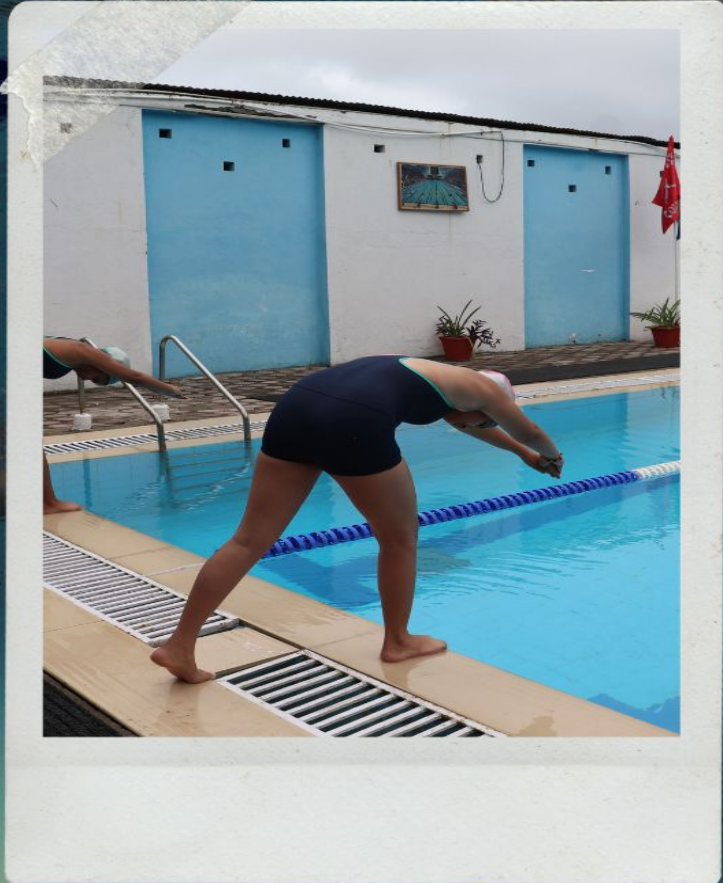




SWIMMING COMPETITION

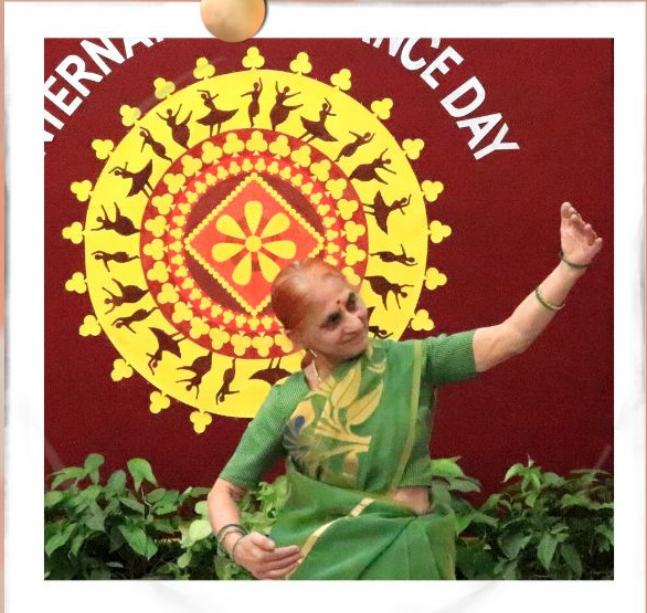
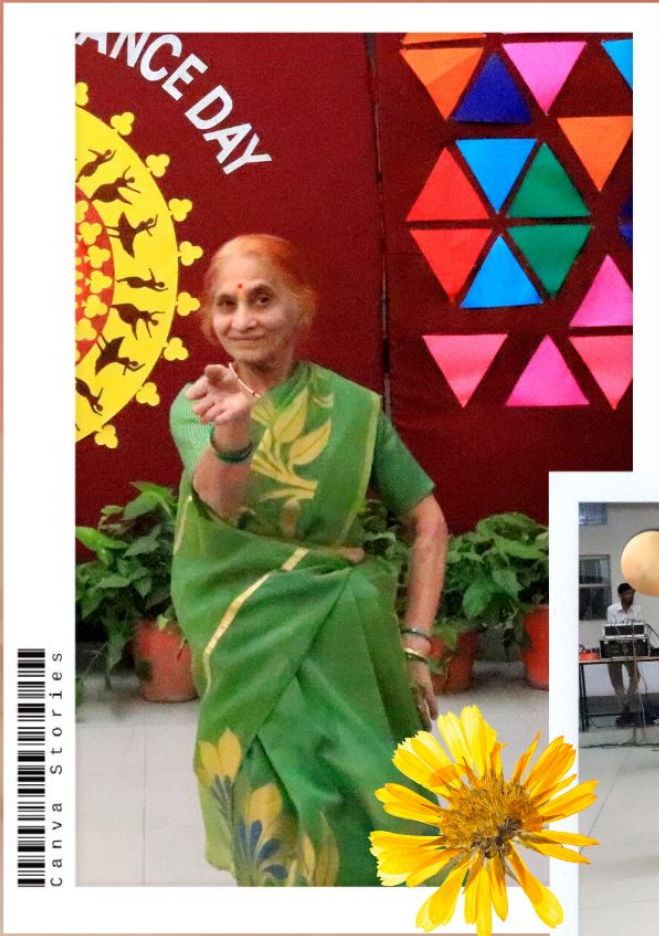


International Dance Day

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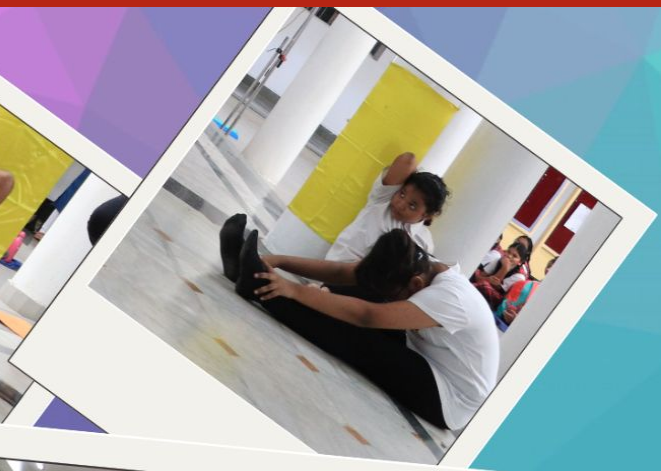
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HAPPY LABOUR DAY

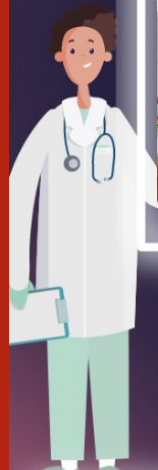
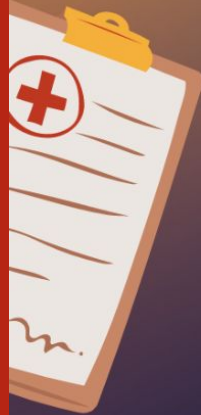




National Doctors' Day

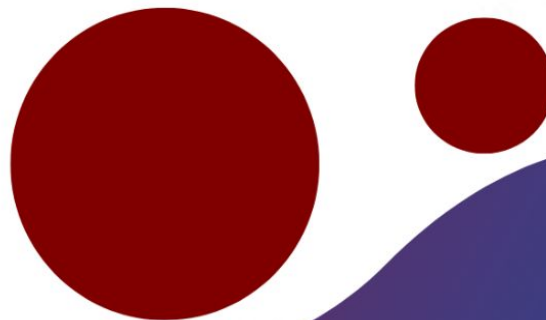
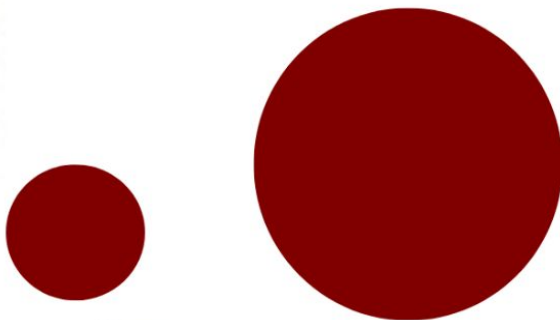
ABHINANDAN

NATURE CONSERVATION DAY

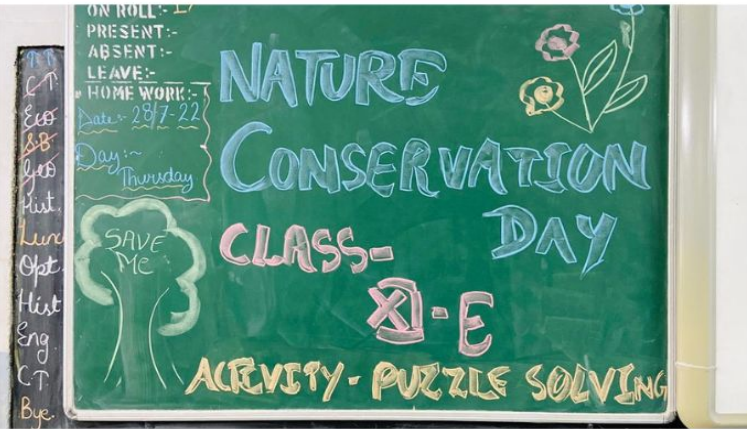

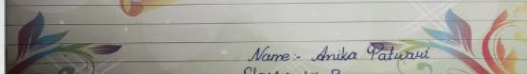

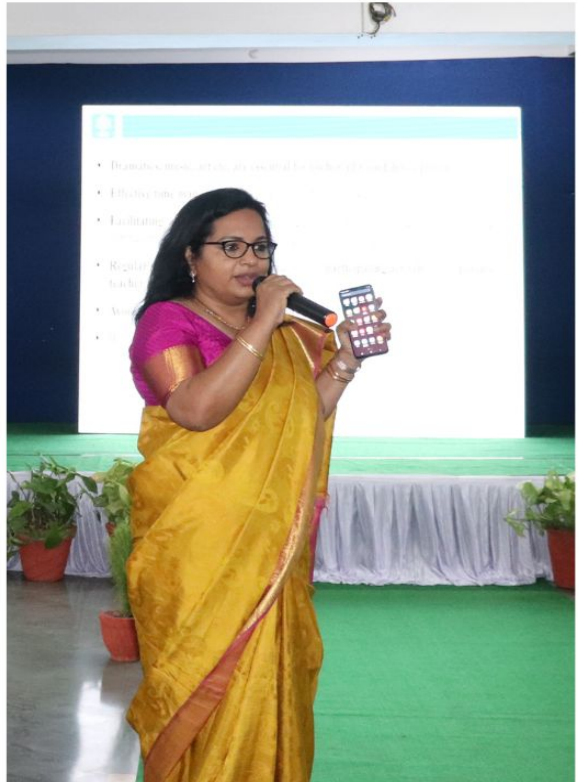




ICS- PARENTS' WORKSHOP
